

CAMPSITE REGULATIONS

1/ Conditions of admission

To enter the campsite, one must have authorization from the receptionist or campsite owner. In staying at Camping de LA BAIE the client accepts the provisions of these regulations and agrees to conform to them. Any breach of these rules may lead to the expulsion of the person concerned, with recourse to the police if necessary.

2/ Police formalities

Anyone who has to stay at least one night in the campsite must first present their identification documents to the head of the reception office and complete the formalities. For obvious reasons of safety (swimming pool, possible evacuation of the campsite in the event of a weather alert ...) or health (hospitalization during the stay ...) minors unaccompanied by their parents are not allowed.

3/ Reception

Reception is open every day, including public holidays, from the opening date to the closing date of the campsite, from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. except in major cases. There you will find all the information on campsite services, information on supply possibilities, sports facilities, tourist attractions in the area and various addresses and information that may prove useful. The telephone can be used according to office hours.

4/ Noise and silence

The campsite users are urged to avoid all noises and discussions that could disturb their neighbors. Sound devices should be adjusted accordingly. Door and trunk closures should be as discreet as possible. Dogs and other animals should never be left free. They should not be left in the campsite, even locked up, in the absence of their masters who are civilly responsible. There must be total silence between 10:30 p.m. and 8 a.m.

5/ Visitors

Visitors may be admitted to the campsite under the responsibility of the campers who receive them after authorization from the manager or his representative. Visitors are required to pay a fee per visitor to the extent that the latter has access to the services and / or facilities of the campsite.

6/ Traffic and parking

Inside the campsite, vehicles must drive at a speed limit of 10 km / h. Vehicles belonging to campers staying there can only circulate in the campsite. Parking should not obstruct traffic, nor prevent the installation of new arrivals. Traffic is prohibited between 10:30 p.m. and 8 a.m.

7/ Appearances of installations

Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene, and appearance of the campsite. It is forbidden to throw polluted water on the ground or in the gutters. Household waste, waste of any kind, paper must be placed in the containers made available to campers. Washing is strictly prohibited outside the bins provided for this purpose. Laundry will be tolerated near shelters, provided it is discreet and does not disturb neighbors. It should never be done from trees.

Plantations and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden to the camper to drive nails in the trees, to cut branches, to make plantations. It is also not allowed to demarcate the site of an installation by personal means, nor to dig the ground. Any degradation committed to the vegetation, to the fences on the ground or to the installations of the camp will be the responsibility of its author.

8/ Security

- a) Fire Open fires and individual charcoal barbecues are strictly prohibited on the sites. Collective barbecues are available to campers. Gas and electric barbecues are permitted. Fire extinguishers and hoses are available to everyone. In case of fire, notify management immediately.
- b) A first aid kit is available at the reception desk, as well as a defibrillator next to the first sanitary block
- c) Electricity- An earth ground is required for all electrical connections.
- d) Theft The management is responsible for items left at reception (individual safes for hire) and has an obligation of surveillance. Immediately report to the manager the presence in the campsite of any suspicious person. However, the camper remains responsible for his own installation and is invited to take the usual precautions to safeguard his equipment.

9/ Games

No violent or disturbing games can be organized near or inside the facilities. Games (ball, boules or rackets) hindering the movement of vehicles are prohibited in the aisles of the campsite.

In the playground areas, and at the entrance to each game, the age groups are indicated and must be respected. The presence of a responsible adult is essential.

10/ Swimming pool

To access the swimming pool, each person must wear a wristband (provided at reception). Anyone (including children) is responsible for swimming in the pool. Please supervise your children and follow the safety instructions.

Constant supervision and the presence of a responsible adult in the pool area are essential.

All children who cannot swim must be equipped with armbands and an orange wristband (supplied at reception). All children under the age of 3 who are not yet potty-trained must wear a special swimming pool nappy.

Please be vigilant, even in the paddling pool, children must be accompanied.

In the waterslide, only one person should go down at a time, and feet first. It is essential to follow the safety instructions at the entrance to the slide.

Campers (children and people staying with them) who do not comply with the above instructions are responsible for their own bathing and use of the slide in the event of an accident.

The management or the person in charge of enforcing the pool rules (July/August) reserves the right to exclude from the pool any person who does not comply with the safety and use instructions for the pool and waterslide. This exclusion may be temporary or permanent.
